- 1. I am an attorney at law licensed to practice in the District of Columbia and Virginia. I am a member of the bar of the Supreme Court and during the time in which I worked on this matter, I was of counsel to Levetown & Jenkins, LLP, a California law firm. Urminder Aulakh (another lawyer of counsel to Levetown & Jenkins) and I originally received a complaint from an AdSense partner, who had been terminated in 2012.
